

Heat Policy

With the recent very hot weather the TRDC has adopted the following heat policy. While most tracking activities take place in the cooler months it can often be hot in March and April

Legal responsibility for the care and welfare of all dogs rest with their owners. Dogs NSW and the TRDC cannot regulate to absolve any party of that responsibility

If the owner cannot ensure that they and the dog is, or will be safe in the heat it is best not to attend the activity

Where the Bureau of Meteorology NSW forecast on the BOM App for the location at or nearest to any TRDC event or activity at 3.00 pm on the day before the activity the forecast maximum temperature is above 30o C the TRDC Committee will make a decision as to whether to maintain the existing arrangements or to cancel the activity

Notification will be at approximately 4.00 pm on the day before the activity via the Club's Facebook page and if possible by an email to all members
